## Notice of Intent to adopt a Tiered Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration for the **Capital SouthEast Connector A1/A2 Kammerer Road Project**

### WHAT IS BEING PLANNED?

The Capital SouthEast Connector Joint Powers Authority (Connector JPA) proposes to improve Kammerer Road between the Interstate 5 (I-5)/Hood Franklin Road Interchange and the State Route 99 (SR-99)/Kammerer Road/Grant Line Road Interchange.

A new four-lane expressway will be constructed between I-5 and Bruceville Road and existing Kammerer Road will be improved to a four-lane thoroughfare between Bruceville Road and SR-99.

The expressway will require a grade-separated crossing of the Union Pacific Railroad. Both the expressway and the thoroughfare will include a Class I bidirectional Multi-Use Path. Additional Project features will include utility relocation, drainage improvements, signalized intersections, and frontage roads. Dependent upon funding, the Connector JPA may construct all or part of this Project. Should construction phasing of the Project be necessary, initial construction may consist of a two-lane facility; however, other construction phasing may be considered.

The Project meets the goals of the proposed project analyzed in the Connector JPA Program Environmental Impact Report (PEIR). The goals of the PEIR include improving mobility, access, and connections between residential and nonresidential land use, which have been compromised by increasing congestion. The Project is intended to link employment centers and residential areas in the transportation corridor and contribute to the remedy for current and future deficiencies in transportation capacity, safety, and land use compatibility. The Project is also intended to improve regional traffic operations, reduce existing and projected congestion, and provide a vital component of the east-west gap closure.

Pursuant to Section 15072(f)(5) of the California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines, it has been determined that the project site is not identified on any of the lists enumerated under Section 65962.5 of the California Government Code pertaining to hazardous wastes.

### WHY THIS PUBLIC NOTICE?

The Connector JPA has studied the effects this project may have on the environment. Our "Initial Study" shows that the proposed project will not significantly affect the quality of the environment with mitigation incorporated, and thus a Mitigated Negative Declaration has been prepared. This Public Notice is to inform you that these documents are available for you to review and that it is the Connector's JPA's intent to adopt an Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) for the project.
