Laura, Lisa and Derek,

The Service agrees that take for the 0.191 acre of federally-listed vernal pool crustacean habitat on the proposed D3/E1 Segment of the Southeast Connector project was previously exempted under the April 2, 2014, biological opinion (Service File 81420-2010-F-0620) issued to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (SPK 2007-02159). This biological opinion was issued for the fill of jurisdictional wetlands for the construction of the 3,510 acre Folsom Plan Area Specific Plan project which included the associated backbone infrastructure. The backbone infrastructure covered the D3/E1 segment of the Southeast Connector project south of White Rock Road in Sacramento County. All terms and conditions of the biological opinion remain unchanged which includes, but is not limited to, the purchase of 0.191 acre of vernal pool creation credits and 0.382 acre of vernal pool preservation credits at a Service-approved bank(s) prior to construction.
